The DF&R Smith and Wesson Revolvers class consists of approximately 15 hours of lecture and 25 hours of bench time.

We will be going over design, function, and repair of the Smith and Wesson Double action swing out cylinder revolvers. Including timing, ranging, aligning crane, removal of ends-hake and so much more. Also a smooth and polish and target trigger job.

REQUIRED FIREARMS:

Minimum of ONE S&W Double Action Swing-out cylinder Revolver...have more? Bring them!
More is better!

Hand Window File (Brownell's carry these)

2 Oz. Ball Peen Hammer

6" Barrett File

6" and 8" Bastard Files

Dial Caliper

Welding goggles

Flat head Screwdriver with head a minimum of .250 wide and shaft of at least 4" in length. We will be modifying this into a tool. An inexpensive or used and well -worn screwdriver works well for this. Can be bought locally in Coquille, if needed.

Toothbrush (for gun cleaning....NOT your teeth)

Dead Blow Hammer

Babbitt bar (Brownell's

Ammo for guns to be used in class.

Shooting Glasses

Hearing protection (For test firing...NOT during Ken's lectures)

Eye protection

*Extra set of springs for the model of gun bringing to class.
